Understanding which areas are planned for visitation will enable us to support the development of any required infrastructure and facilities, and provide guidance as required to improve your journey.

We kindly request that visitors follow the below guidelines:

- Mayala Country is a remote natural environment with unpredictable and hazardous conditions. Please ensure you have all relevant safety equipment for your visit.
- Please do not take anything from Mayala Country, including any living or dead plant or animal specimens.
- Please do not take photos, film or reproduce images of Mayala Country on any media for commercial purposes or media sharing platforms without first obtaining written permission from Mayala Inninalang Aboriginal Corporation.
- Please do not bring any animal (including domesticated animal / pet) or plant specimens onto Mayala Islands.
- Please bury all human waste at least 100m from any watercourse, do not use soaps or detergents in freshwater streams or pools and do any washing or cleaning in the ocean.
- Please limit fires to those required for cooking and ensure they are in clear, open, sandy spaces, and fully extinguished.
- Please take all rubbish home with you and where possible we would greatly appreciate your cooperation in removing any existing rubbish and debris from Mayala Country.
