Camping in the Blackwood District

Travel time

All Blackwood district campgrounds are located within a 3.5 hour drive south of Perth.

Fees

All Blackwood District national parks are free to enter. Camping fees apply at all campgrounds and reserves. These fees contribute to the provision and maintenance of recreational facilities and visitor services throughout the campgrounds. All campgrounds must be booked online prior to arrival using the Park Stay website parkstay.dbca.wa.gov.au

Booking

Check campsite details and campground map carefully when booking. Some campsites are subject to standing water after heavy rain, and not all campsites within a campground offer the same facilities. All sites are unpowered, and all toilets are no-flush pit toilets.

Leave No Trace

Plan ahead and prepare.
Remember your safety is our concern but your responsibility.



Travel and camp on durable surfaces. Help us to protect these sensitive environments by keeping within the existing footprint of the established campsites and forest tracks.

Dispose of waste properly. Please use bins provided or take your rubbish with you and recycle where possible.

Leave what you find. These areas are home to many species. Respect the unique environment and leave it as you found it.

Minimise campfire impacts. Campfires are permitted with seasonal restrictions and in provided fire rings only. If possible, bring your own firewood as collecting firewood, kindling and leaves is not permitted in national parks or other conservation reserves. Firewood should always be sourced locally to prevent the spread of pests and disease.

Respect for native wildlife. Please do not feed native wildlife. Dogs are permitted at some campgrounds. Ensure they are under control and on a leash at all times.

Be considerate of other visitors. Keep noise to a minimum and note that generators are not permitted at any time.

Camping Tips

- Book online before you go. All sites must be booked prior to your stay and mobile reception is not always available at the campground. Visit parkstay.dbca.wa.gov.au to book.
- Bring your own firewood as firewood collection from around the campground is not permitted. Firewood is no longer being provided at any campgrounds. Firewood should be purchased locally or sourced from DBCA's closest approved firewood collection area to prevent the spread of pests and diseases such as Polyphagous shot-hole borer. - Bring your own drinking water as tank water is not always available and requires treatment before consuming.
- Be aware that DBCA conduct regular 1080 fox and feral cat baiting as a part of its *Western Shield* program. Baited areas must always be considered dangerous for pets. 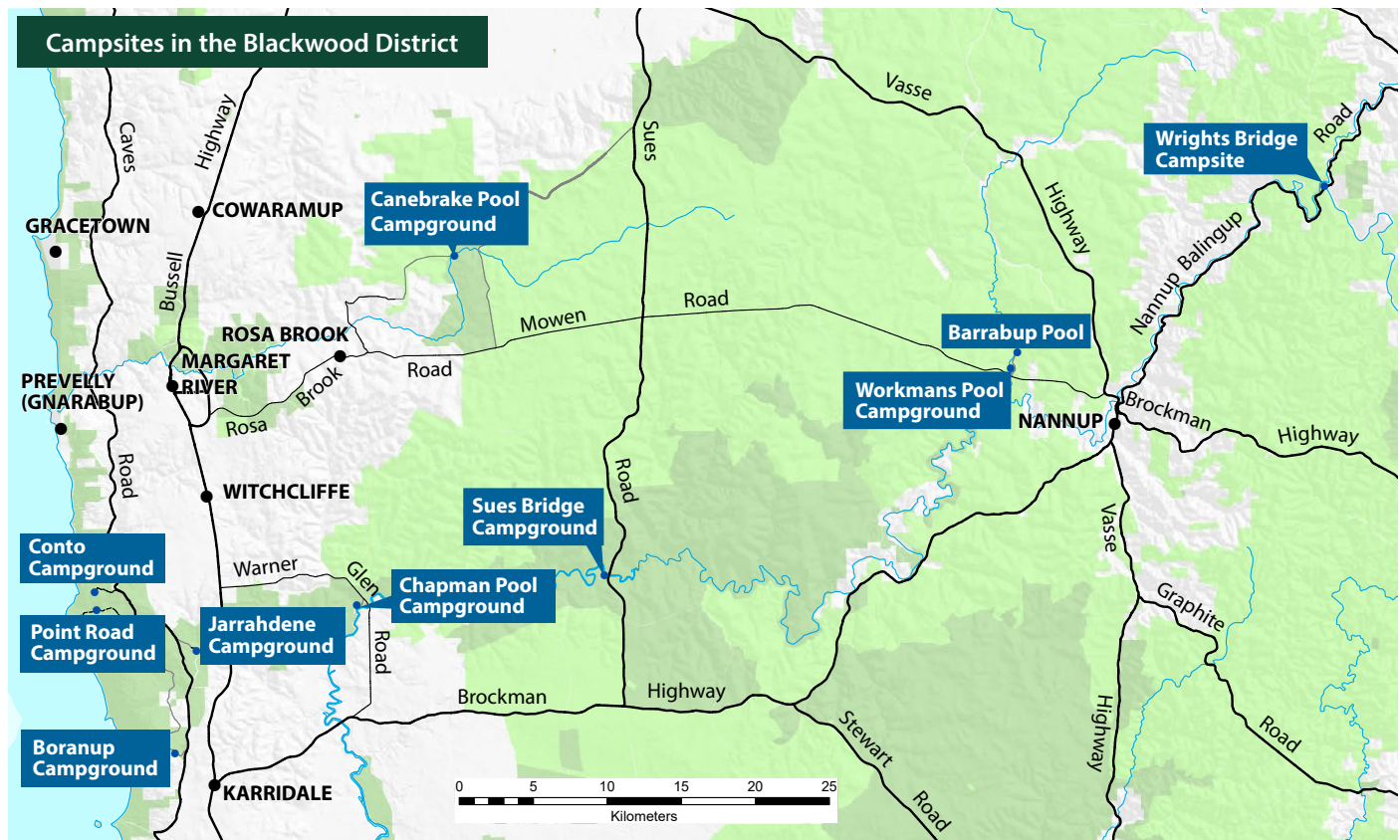
