







Major island rookeries where artificial light controls are recommended for overnight anchoring


Legend

To minimise disorientation of wedge-tailed shearwater fledglings and marine turtle hatchlings that may be present during the eclipse period, a darkness zone should be maintained within 1.5km of the island rookeries indicated on the map. If overnight anchoring within the darkness zone is unavoidable, please implement artificial light controls such as drawing curtains and minimising lights that aren't required for safety or navigational purposes (including underwater lights).
